Any high school drumline. All members of the drumline must be in compliance with all U.I.L. and H.B. 72 extracurricular activity and eligibility rules.

PHOTO AND RECORDING POLICIES

Still cameras are allowed and may be used from stadium seating. Video and audio recording are not permitted, with the exception of the Director's Video Designee who will be provided with a pass for this purpose.

EVENT FORMAT

Warm-up lasts 45 minutes. You will have an assigned guide. We plan 15 minutes of travel time to the entry gate. You have 30 minutes total to enter, perform, receive comments/clinic and exit the field. No minimum time requirement. Three drumline clinicians critique all components of the stadium performance and make constructive comments in an effort to promote improvement and solidify achievement.

PRE-SHOW ANNOUNCEMENT

Your time will begin at the cue of our Field Operations official. You may cue that official when you are ready for the announcement and it will begin as follows:

DRUMLINE TIMING AND MOVEMENT

Warm-up lasts 45 minutes. You will have an assigned guide. We plan 15 minutes of travel time to the entry gate. You have 30 minutes total to enter, perform, receive comments/clinic and exit the field. No minimum time requirement.

DRUMLINE ADJUDICATION AND SCORING

Three drumline clinicians critique all components of the stadium performance and make constructive comments in an effort to promote improvement and

solidify achievement. Scoring will be an average of the scores from each of the three judges with a maximum score of 1000 points given by each judge.

1000 Points (Execution 500, Musicality 250, General Effect 250)

ARRIVAL AND CHECK-IN

The Traffic & Parking team will be in the parking lot to assist your bus and truck drivers with parking. Your check-in time is at least 45 minutes prior to your warm-up time. The check in desk will be under the tent by the bus and truck parking.

STADIUM POWER

Electrical power is available at the 50-Yard line at field level. Please bring your own power cables/extension cords, they will not be provided.

DIRECTORS AND FIELD PASSES

Up to 5 directors receive wristbands. Field pass wristbands must travel through warm up and field performance with the performing ensemble. Up to 10 extra volunteer passes may be included but must travel with the performing ensemble. You will receive these at check-in. More may be purchased at the gate.

PARKING LOT WARM-UP

Electrical power will be available for you in your warm up area. It is your responsibility to arrive at your warm up and performance on time. If you arrive late you must still exit at the scheduled time. Volunteers will assist with timing and movement. Be aware that wireless microphones, transmitters and other devices may interfere with performances in the stadium. Avoid any such wireless signals while in the warm up area.

TIMING AND MOVEMENT

You have 45 minutes of Parking Lot time. We plan 15 minutes of travel time to the entry gate. You have 30 minutes total to enter, perform, receive clinician comments and exit the field. There is no minimum time requirement.

FIRST AID AND WATER

There will be a minimal First-Aid station available. Dehydration issues are most common. Please make sure your students are well hydrated before warm-up and performance.

RE-ENTRY

A wristband handed out by our Officials will allow attendees to re-enter the stadium.

STUDENT LEADER AWARDS RETREAT

Be advised that there will be a retreat! Even if your group departs, we would like you to send representatives from your drumline back to participate in the awards ceremony culmination. Every participating group will be recognized. Instruct your student leaders to report to the entry gate Official at the end of the contest, when the last performing drumline takes the field. If your drumline will not be represented at the awards ceremony, please make us aware of that ahead of time.
